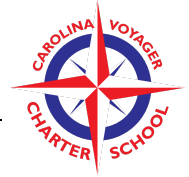


Carolina Voyager Charter School  
**Student Technology Device Agreement**

Carolina Voyager students and parents are required to review this document as well as sign the accompanying agreement to protect the hardware and software inherent with this technology.

Technology resources at Carolina Voyager are provided for the purpose of supporting the educational mission of the school. Our school's goal in providing the iPad/Chromebook is to promote educational excellence by facilitating resource sharing, innovation, research, creativity, communication, increased productivity, and mobile learning.

Use of these technologies is a privilege that carries responsibility and behavioral expectations consistent with all school rules and policies including, but not limited to, those stated in the Student Handbook. It is understood that members of the Carolina Voyager community will use all types of computing devices and our school's network in a responsible, ethical, and legal manner at all times.

1. Carolina Voyager retains sole right of possession of the iPad/Chromebook and related equipment. An iPad/ Chromebook will be issued to students according to the guidelines set forth in this document. Carolina Voyager retains the right to collect and/or inspect the iPad/Chromebook at any time; and to alter, add, or delete installed software or hardware.
2. iPads/Chromebooks will be distributed near the beginning of the school year. Parents and students must sign and return this Technology Agreement and pay the technology insurance fee prior to students being able to take home their assigned technology device. iPads/Chromebooks will be returned during the final month of school. Students who transfer or withdraw from Carolina Voyager during the school year must surrender their device upon termination of enrollment.
3. Students are responsible for the general care of the technology they have been issued by the school. Technology that is broken or fails to work properly must be taken to the Main Office for an evaluation of the equipment.
  - a. **Do not attempt to repair a damaged or malfunctioning device.**  
Loaner devices will be issued to students when their assigned device has been sent for repair. The loaner device will stay at school until the repair is completed. If the device is broken a second time, the student will lose the privilege of taking it home.
4. Devices must be in a protective case at all times. Do not attempt to remove iPads from their cases. Devices must remain free of any writing, drawing, stickers, or labels.

5. Screens should be cleaned with a soft, dry cloth or anti-static cloth; no cleaners of any type should be used. Please keep the devices away from extreme hot or cold. Keep food and drink away from all technology.
6. Students must be responsible for bringing their device, FULLY CHARGED to school each morning.
7. The lock screen background will be a picture of the student. Students are not to change their background picture. Students are not permitted to personal passcodes on their devices. (School will issue passwords as needed).
8. Parents are allowed to connect to a wireless network on their children's device to assist them with homework and projects as needed, however parents must monitor and ensure proper use at all times.
  - a. The devices are for student use only. Please do not allow siblings or other persons to use the iPad.
9. Carolina Voyager will synchronize the devices to contain the necessary Apps for schoolwork while at school. Students **must not synch** through a home accounts. The software/Apps originally installed by Carolina Voyager must remain on the device in usable condition and be easily accessible at all times.
10. Students will receive a charger the first time they are issued an iPad. The charger is the responsibility of the family ... and then the part that you have. Chromebook chargers must be returned at the conclusion of each school year.
11. Parents are responsible for providing headphones for their child. If headphones break during the school year, parents will be asked to provide another set..

This policy is provided to make all users aware of the responsibilities associated with efficient, ethical, and lawful use of technology resources. If a person violates any of the User Terms and Conditions named in this policy, privileges may be suspended or terminated.

Parents are advised to talk to your children about values and the standards that your children should follow on the use of the Internet, just as you do on the use of all media information sources such as television, telephones, movies, and radio. Parents are also advised to monitor their children's use of their device at home.

I understand that it is impossible for Carolina Voyager to restrict access to all controversial materials, and I will not hold the school responsible for materials accessed on the network. The school is employing rigorous filtering software, both on our server and the iPad/Chromebook, however no filter is flawless.

I accept full responsibility if and when my child's use of technology is not in the school setting, and understand that my child is subject to the same rules and agreements while not in school. The filtering software installed on our iPads/Chromebooks should restrict access from many websites even when away from our school network, but again parents must monitor their children's access when on the Internet.

**\*\*Voyager charges a Technology Insurance Fee of \$60 per device if the student/parent wishes to bring their device home. This will cover accidental breaks, etc. Without purchasing insurance, the parent/guardian acknowledges they must pay full retail price to replace any damaged or lost device issued to their child(ren).**

***If a device is damaged, broken, or stolen - I agree that it will be reported to the School Office within 24 hours.***
