If anyone has an extra keyboard they'd be willing to let me use, please let me know. I should have enough, but it doesn't hurt to have a few extras as backups.

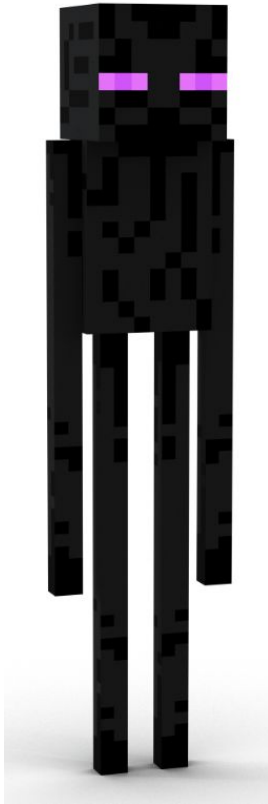

MakeCode|MineCraft [Grades 5-7]

This is an accelerated intro to Computer Science course designed for students between the ages of 11-14 (**highly-motivated** 3rd and 4th graders will be considered.) We will have two meetings per week - students should not join if they cannot attend both meeting times. We will cover 10 units, nearly 30 lessons, in only 20 meetings. The accelerated pace makes full participation necessary.

This course will introduce students to core computer science and programming concepts and computational thinking skills. It builds on the popularity of Minecraft, featuring Minecraft Education Edition, and introduces Microsoft MakeCode, a block- and JavaScript-programming editor in the free Code Connection app.

A \$5 Minecraft for Education license is included in the fee for the course. This license is good for one year after activation. ****Space is Limited****

Learning goals

By the end of this course, students will be able to:

- Change their Minecraft world through coding in Microsoft MakeCode.
- Describe and apply the following programming concepts:
 - * Events
 - * Coordinates
 - * Conditionals
 - * Coordinates
 - * Variables
 - * Iteration
 - * Functions and parameters
 - * Arrays
 - * Artificial intelligence
- Synthesize the concepts in new, creative ways through self-directed coding projects.
