**Please describe your plan for instructional delivery during the time of closure (e.g. paper and pencil packets, virtual instruction or materials, etc.)**

Here is our instructional plan for the 4th Graders at CVCS:

- We have created one Google Classroom for both classes -- 4th Grade Remote Learning. We are going to combine assignments across the grade in both classes.
- Your student needs to go to <https://classroom.google.com/> and log-in with their carolina voyager username and password. If they do not have either, please email us and we'll look it up for you. Then, our new code is **5ekubct** -- after entering it, you should be able to access the new class.
- Starting Wednesday March 18, you will find a new Reading Assignment and a new Writing Assignment in the Classroom every morning. Students should complete them each day.
- All reading assignments come from the book The One and Only Ivan -- students will have access to a digital copy of the book through the Google Classroom, if you would like to pick up a paperback copy -- we have about 20 at the school. You are welcome to pick one up on Tuesday, March 17.
- Most writing assignments use the website <https://newsela.com/>. The assignments are listed by article -- so students need to match the article from the Google Classroom assignment to the list of articles in Newsela. Each student should have their password to Newsela -- we use it regularly. Just contact us, if your student does not remember theirs.
- We are going to use USA Test Prep for Math <https://www.usatestprep.com/member-login?logout=1> Again, students should know their passwords. In this, the Account ID is carolina 91, login is your student's first name.last name, and password is Carolina. Everyday, students will have a Math lesson to complete.
- Additionally, students can continue their personal learning paths via iReady in Reading and Math. We recommend that students spend 20-30 minutes everyday on both Math and Reading in iReady.
- Special Area teachers are creating their own plans for each week.
- We are trying to create 200 minutes of instruction each day (our lessons + Special Area + iReady). Please let us know if

our lessons are taking your kids much shorter or longer than that.

If you have not already done so, please let Kelly or I know if your student has a technology device and internet at home to complete online assignments. There is no need to come to school tomorrow on Tuesday March 17 to pick up anything if your child can complete all work online. If needed, we have made packets of work available and there are paper copies of The One and Only Ivan that can be picked up in school.

We know this is a lot and thank you for your patience getting this all up and running. Please stay safe at home and we hope to see everyone back in April.
